Dear Parents/Carers,

We hope this letter finds you well. We are writing to you to remind everyone of the uniform expectations at Barrs Court Primary School.

As you know, wearing a uniform has many benefits, including promoting a sense of pride in our school and creating a level playing field for all children. It also helps to ensure that children are dressed appropriately for a day of learning, and saves families time in choosing what to wear each day. At Barrs Court Primary School, we have a clear uniform policy that all children are expected to adhere to.

This includes:

Winter:

- Black shoes (not boots or trainers)
- Black or Navy:
- Trousers (straight leg, not hipsters or culottes)
- Skirt (knee-length)
- Pinafore with a zip at the front
- Gold polo shirt (Navy polo shirt in Year 5 & 6) (with or without the school logo)
- Navy Barrs Court Sweatshirt or Cardigan (with or without the school logo)
- Black or Navy socks/tights

Summer Alternatives:

- Black or Navy Shorts
- Navy or Pale Blue Dress (gingham or stripes)
- White socks
- Black or Navy shoes (not sandals)

PE Kit to wear on PE days:

- Black or Navy shorts
- Gold T-Shirt (with or without the school logo)
- Daps/Trainers
- Black or Navy tracksuit bottoms (optional) for outdoor PE

Items of Jewellery (including earrings)

It is also important to note that we do not allow any jewellery to be worn in school, with the exception of small stud earrings and a watch. NOT A SMART WATCH.

Stud earrings may be taped over for up to 6 weeks after the initial piercing during PE and sports club sessions. After this period of time, they should be removed by the child before the session or if this is not possible, removed by an adult at home on the day of the physical activity before coming to school.

Hair & Accessories

Hairstyles should be appropriate for a school setting and long hair should be tied back. Hair accessories should be minimal and in the school colours.

Additional Information:

In instances of extreme temperatures, we will send out additional information on recommended attire so that the children can be as comfortable as possible in school.
