





# Barrs Court PTFA Colour Fun Run 2025 FAQs

**Dear Parents and Carers** 

We are looking forward to see you all for our first ever colour run on <u>Friday 6<sup>th</sup> June</u> from 3:15pm on the school field.

#### What is a Colour Run?

The children will run around the course as a class, whilst coloured powder is thrown over them as they navigate various obstacles along the route. The aim is to have fun and become as colourful as possible whilst fundraising to finish payment for the new Trim Trail for the school playground.

#### What Does My Child Need to Take Part?

- Please send in a white T-shirt and old pair or joggers/shorts and trainers for your child to change into at school before taking part (If your child would like to run but not have paint thrown at them, please dress them in a brightly coloured t-shirt so our volunteers know to avoid throwing any powder on them.)
- 2. A pair of goggles or sunglasses to protect their eyes is recommended.

#### Is A Colour Run Safe?

The coloured powder is safe, non-toxic and made from natural ingredients, however we do recommend all children to wear goggles or sunglasses. There will be a first aid station with an eye wash area at the event.

Not all paints are as safe as the one we are using therefore it is especially important that **NO OTHER POWDERS ARE BROUGHT INTO THE EVENT** for safety reasons. We will have some individual sachets of powder you can purchase for £1 to throw over your child at the end of the course.

### **How Will the Event Run?**

The children will run in their classes, with the youngest children running first. Children will come out of school at 3:15pm with their class and will be able to watch the event before their turn. Children will run the course twice before finishing the race and being able to take some fab photos with their friends. The Cabin will be open selling drinks, ice creams and lollies, sweet treats and crisps to refuel after all that activity!

We will be selling individual powder sachets for £1 if you wish to buy them and The Cabin will be open to purchase snacks and drinks if you wish.

All children will have now brought home sponsorship forms to try and raise some sponsorship for their efforts. There is no set amount to raise to take part, but we will be providing a class treat for the class who raises the highest amount!

## **How Does My Child Get Sponsorship?**

You can use the sponsorship form to keep track of your sponsors and you can hand this in with the money either on the day of the event, or at one of the PTFA stands in the playground in the days leading up to the event (more details to follow). We will also be able to accept sponsorship money to be paid by card if you prefer.

IF YOU HAVE ALREADY HANDED IN YOUR SPONSORSHIP FORM AND MONEY FROM SEPTEMBER YOU DO NOT NEED TO HAND ANYTHING ELSE IN THIS TIME, UNLESS YOU HAVE RAISED EVEN MORE MONEY SINCE!
