# Making maths meaningful

Number Day is a great way to make maths fun and bring about a positive, 'can-do' attitude towards it. On **Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2024**, we will be having a fun day of maths activities in school. Children will take part in activities in their classes.

We will also be taking part in *Dress up for Digits*. Pupils are asked to wear an item of clothing with a number on it (football shirt, cap, netball shirt). Or why not get even more creative. Children could design a unique t shirt, hat or even become a human-sized calculator or dice!

# Children can also take part in a friendly competition called NSPCC Rocks on Times Table Rock Stars where they will compete against other classes and schools nationally. The competition runs from 07:30 to 19:30 on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> February. Children can play in any game mode with every correct answer to a multiplication or division question, earning themselves, their class and the school a point. The Times Tables Rock Stars platform will calculate the class average. Winning classes in the school and in the competition as a whole will be the ones with the highest average. To support player well-being, there is a daily time limit of 60 minutes per player. Once the player goes beyond 60 minutes of play on that day, they will still earn coins but will no longer earn points towards the competition.
