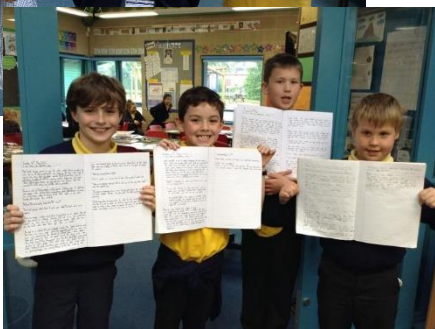
Friendly Yr 5/6 Football match
