

<u>Details for the day</u>: Gates open at 9am for registration and a 9:30am start. We are aiming to finish by 12:30pm depending on how far your team gets into the competition and how many teams enter. Please wear footwear and clothing suitable for being outside on the field.

The PTFA have kindly agreed to open the hut for people to buy refreshments on the morning of the event. What is Kubb: Kubb is a fun game which originated in Scandinavia. It involves throwing batons underarm at target blocks of wood or "Kubbs" and finally knocking over the King Kubb. To get a basic sense of the game and its rules, you could look at the following link on Youtube: Kubb Rules | How to Play Kubb - YouTube. There will be some slight variations on rules on the day but the basics are all there for you.

<u>Team size</u>: 2 or 3 people. £2 per person to enter (payable to the school office when entering). We recommend that participants are Year 5 or older and teams can be child-only, a mix of children and adults or just adults. There will be no divisions based on age! Younger children can watch the matches.
