What have we been up to?

Enquiry lessons

We have started our new enquiry, 'What is darkness?' and the children have thought about the differences between night and day and sources of light. Next week we will learn about nocturnal animals (we took a trip to the moat area to see evidence of nocturnal animals this afternoon!).

Phonics

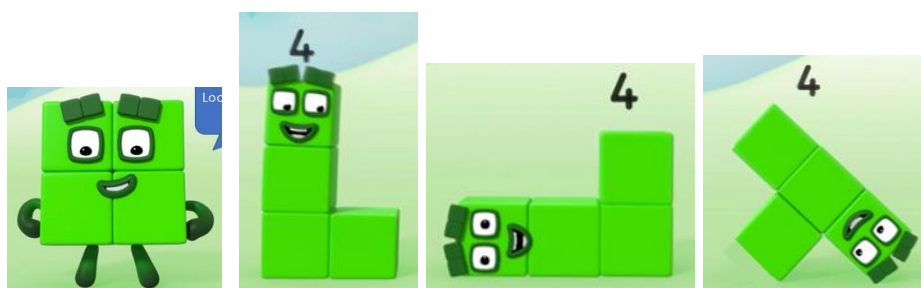
Your child now has g/o/c/k and the tricky word 'is' in their sound pack. All books have been changed
