

SUPERHEROES!

Hook Day

Friday 8th September. We have invited the children to come to school dressed as a superhero. Children will take part in lots of fun superhero themed activities to kick start our exciting topic.



English

Children will be inspired to write through a variety of superhero themed stories which we will read in our Big Read lessons. Within our lessons, we will be focusing on using our phonics to sound out and spelling common exception words from memory, as well as using sentence punctuation correctly. Children will also learn to write for a range of purposes including adding labels and captions to diagrams and writing instructions for others.

Maths

Our Maths this term, will be focused on place value. Children will count, recognise, write, order and represent numbers in different ways. They will also develop their addition and subtraction skills. Through our daily CLIC sessions, children will also be working on the recall of the 'Learn it' facts for term 1.

What can you do at home?

Reading: Listen to your child read 5 times each week.

Homework: Help your child to complete their weekly phonics homework and return the book to school every Friday.

PE: Ensure your child has their PE kit in school.

Geography

Children will be exploring simple maps, globes and atlases. They will learn to name and locate the 4 countries that make up the UK as well as the world's continents and oceans as they track the journeys of superheroes.

PE

Children will learn skills and tactics needed for various invasion games such as throwing, catching and dodging. They will then learn to play Bench ball.



RE

Through a variety of activities, children will explore the question 'Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?'

Science

Children will learn to identify, name and label parts of the human body. They will explore the 5 senses and recognise which part of the body is associated with each sense. Children will also learn about an animal's basic needs for survival (including humans) as well as the importance of exercise, a balanced diet and good hygiene.

Music

Children will listen to and accompany superhero theme tunes. They will discuss the pitch and tempo and they will also sing superhero songs.

Computing

In computing, children will learn about the importance of e-safety. They will learn to recognise how to behave safely and responsibly when using the internet.

PSHE

The theme 'Our happy school' focuses on new beginnings and creating a happy, supportive and collaborative learning environment. Children will develop a sense of belonging and will take ownership over the rules they set for their classroom.

French

Children will learn simple greetings, to introduce themselves and to answer the register in French.

DT

Our DT this term will be linked to our science theme of healthy eating. Children will learn to cut, peel and assemble food to create a healthy fruit kebab.
