"Time Travellers"

How do things change over time?

<p><u>Geography:</u> In Geography we will be investigating rivers, mountains and coasts, particularly studying the physical processes that take place in these locations over time such as erosion and tidal currents. We will be researching sites in the United Kingdom as well as throughout the world.</p>	<p><u>Science:</u> In Science we will be investigating evolution over time and how one generation inherits traits from the previous one. The children will have the opportunity to plan and carry out investigations as well as research this topic.</p>	<p><u>RE:</u> Children will be looking at what matters most to Christians and Humanists.</p>
<p><u>PSHE/ Citizenship:</u> In our class and area assemblies we will be learning about how we can develop skills to resolve issues when we fall out with our friends and how we can get on together better. We will also learn about healthy lifestyle choices.</p>	<p><u>PE:</u> In PE we will be developing our gymnastics skills and learning how to play Pop Lacrosse. The final swimming sessions for the year will take place in Term 3.</p>	<p><u>DT:</u> In DT we will be carrying out investigations to decide on the most effective and appropriate bridge building materials. We will design, make and evaluate how we can create durable and effective bridges that can hold a heavy load!</p>
<p><u>Languages:</u> The children will continue their French lessons, looking in particular at dates and times and the school day including the names of different subjects.</p>	<p><u>Music:</u> Children will be looking at listening and musical notation. They will consider why is listening important and what is musical notation? The children will be studying the globally recognised form of musical notation involving a range of notes and staves.</p>	<p><u>Art:</u> In Art, the children will be looking at the Pop Art movement of the 1950s. The children will be studying the work of artists such as Andy Warhol and Peter Blake and creating their own Pop Art inspired art using a variety of mediums.</p>
<p><u>Computing:</u> In Computing, the focus of study for the term is data handling. The children will be using Microsoft Excel to input and manipulate data and create spreadsheets and databases.</p>	<p><u>English:</u> Our first book of the term will be "Clockwork" by Phillip Pullman.</p>
