



## SCHOOL DINNERS FOR TERMS ONE & TWO

2019/20

### Blue & Green Areas

The cost of a hot two-course lunch is £2.20:

1 dinner	-	£2.20
2 dinners	-	£4.40
3 dinners	-	£6.60
4 dinners	-	£8.80
5 dinners	-	£11.00

IF YOU WISH TO PAY FOR TERM 1 AND/OR TERM 2 IN ADVANCE, THE AMOUNTS ARE AS FOLLOWS:-

**TERM ONE** - Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019 - Friday 26<sup>th</sup> October 2019 (Inset Day on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> September)

- **Green Area ONLY** - 39 days @ £2.20 per day = £85.80
- **Blue Area ONLY** - 38 days @ £2.20 per day (We the Curious Trip 12<sup>th</sup> September ) = £83.60

**TERM TWO** Monday 5<sup>th</sup> November 2019 - Friday 21<sup>st</sup> December 2019

- 34 days @ £2.20 per day (Church Service Monday 16<sup>th</sup> December) = £74.80

**TOTAL FOR TERMS ONE & TWO:**

- **Green Area ONLY** - 73 days @ £2.20 per day = £160.60
- **Blue Area ONLY** - 72 days @ £2.20 per day = £158.40

### **Guidelines for children staying for school dinners:**

The school uses an on-line payment system for parents to pay for school dinners for their child(ren). Please visit [www.parentpay.com](http://www.parentpay.com) to log in. To sign in, you need your user name and password and will have previously been provided with an activation code to set up your account. It would be most helpful if the amounts paid in to cover school dinners could be in multiples of £2.20. Please book and pay for your child's lunch in advance and specify which meals they will be having - dinner registers are not taken in class. If you have any issues with logging on to the system, please contact the school office for assistance.

The kitchen will cook the meals from orders received by 9.15am each day. If your child arrives after this time, they will need to bring a packed lunch unless previous notification has been received.

### **FREE SCHOOL MEALS**

Many families may be eligible for free school meals. Applications are treated in strict confidence. You may be eligible for help if you fall into one of the following categories:

Your child might be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

How to apply for free school meals:

You can apply online to South Gloucestershire Council via the Citizen Portal using the link below. They will then check your eligibility and let you know whether you qualify. **Please note**, if you have already completed a primary or secondary school place application for the 2018/19 academic year via the portal, you do not need to re-register when applying for free school meals. Please use the login details that you have already set up.
